We are so glad you are a Donald R. Getty student! Donald R. Getty students work hard every day to learn, grow, and share with their teachers and classmates. To help all students know what they need to do to be successful, we have a **Success Commitment** for students and parents to read and sign together.

Donald R. Getty K-9 School Student Code of Conduct

A Donald R. Getty student takes care to be kind and respectful. That means:

- We are polite to visitors and people in our community.
- We take care of our community by putting litter in the garbage and being careful not to play in the trees or break branches off our trees.
- We keep our school clean by taking off our outdoor shoes or boots at the mat, and putting our indoor shoes on at our cubbies.
- We help our school and the environment by putting garbage and recycling in the right cans.
- We wear clothes that are right for the season.
- We come to school on time with the things we need to learn.
- We do our homework and home-reading, and use our agendas to help us remember what to do at home.
- We remember to give respect, take responsibility and build relationships.
- A Donald R. Getty student always does their best!

It is important to follow these rules so everyone is safe and ready to learn. If you need help to follow these rules, Donald R. Getty K-9 School staff may:

- Talk to you about how to behave
- Remove privileges for a short or long time (move your desk, not allow the use of technology, etc.)
- Have you work outside your classroom or in the office
- Have you stay in at recess for a detention
- Make a space for you to work in another classroom
- Take away toys or games that are distracting or not appropriate to have at school
- Call your parents to come talk to the principal
- Do community service to give back
- Have you work in the office for the day (In-School suspension)
- Have you work at home with your parents (Out-Of-School-Suspension)
- Ask you to pay back damage to the school, or individual(s)
- Involve other people to help the school problem solve with your parents, like a social worker, police, or the Alberta Attendance Board.



Donald R. Getty K-9 School Dress Code

What does a Donald R. Getty student wear?

- Clothes that are clean and don't have rips or tears.
- Clothes that fit just right. We don't show our underwear and we wear shirts that cover our bellies.
- Clothes that don't have bad words or scary pictures on them.
- We wear our jackets, hats, boots, and mitts outside, but we put them away in our cubbies/lockers when we are inside.
- Some people wear head covers because of their religion. (Those are not the same as a hat.)
- Donald R. Getty students always dress for the weather! They bring mittens, hats, winter coats, boots, and snow pants when it is very cold. If you forget, the office will phone home to ask someone to bring you warm clothes.
- We make sure we have proper shoes for gym classes.

Donald R. Getty Students Come to School!

We are counting on you each and every day to be at school to learn and grow! If you are sick or will be away, your parents need to call us so we know you are safe. When you come back to school, you will work with your teacher to see what you missed.

Coming to School After the Bell

If you come to school after our start time, don't be afraid if the doors are locked. Come to the front door, ring the bell and we will let you in.

If class has already started, you need to come to the office to let us know you are here. We will give you a slip that tells your teacher that we know you made it to school safe.

Donald R. Getty K-9 School Campus Supervision and Playground

Donald R. Getty School opens its doors at 8:15 am each day and classes begin at 8:30. There are supervisors inside and outside. Before 8:15 am, the school is closed to parents and students. Just in case you want to play with your friends on the playground, we have another bell at 8:25 am that rings outside to let you know that it's time to come in and get ready for school!

We go outside every day, unless it gets too cold (below -24°C). When it's that cold, you can come in at 8:15 am and wait by your cubby quietly for your teacher to invite you into the classroom. Sometimes we have to have indoor recesses when it's that cold, and even though it's recess, we are still respectful of all the other students and groups in our building who need us to use inside voices.

Donald R. Getty teachers and your parents want you to be SAFE. All students **must** stay on the Donald R. Getty park area from the time you get to school in the morning until you leave for home in the afternoon. You must not play in the parking lot, drop off zone or neighbors' yards or homes. We never cross streets at recess or throw objects or snowballs over the fence or onto the road. A Donald R. Getty student always plays safe!

Donald R. Getty K-9 School Technology Usage Agreement

I agree to follow these rules when I use a device in school (like iPads, computers, phones & handheld games). I understand that the rules are the same whether I use a school tool or I bring mine from home.

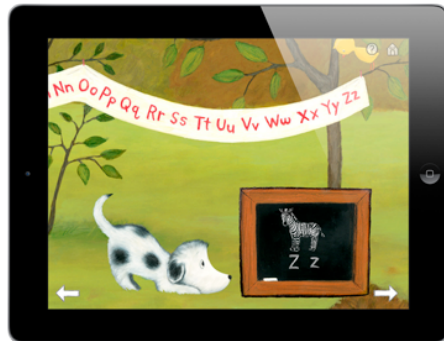
1. I will only use a device after my teacher has given me permission. I am not to take it or use it without asking. It will only be used for school work.



2. I will listen carefully to my teacher and follow directions when I use a device.



3. My teacher may let me use apps to help me learn but I will not ask to play games or download apps that my teacher has not given me permission to use.



4. I will not touch another person's technology.
5. When my teacher needs me to listen, I will put the device on the desk upside down or close the screen, so that I can focus on my teacher.



6. I will keep the volume off so I don't bother anyone. If I need to hear, I will ask my teacher if I can get my headphones.

6. I will always put my device away where it belongs. I want to make sure it is charged and where I can find it when I need to use it next time!



8. I will never take a device to the bathroom. Donald R. Getty devices will remain inside the school at all time.

9. I will not take pictures or videos unless I am asked. I will not take pictures of people that they don't want me to or that they don't know I'm taking. I never use my device to be mean.

10. My teachers are always welcome to check my device, whether it's mine or the school's, because I know they want to make use I am using it properly.

If I break these rules, I understand that I may need a time-out from using technology, and that my teacher will call home to let my parents know.
